

PT. Sumatera Prima Fibreboard (SPF) is Indonesia's largest Medium Density Fibreboard (MDF) producer, renowned for its commitment to environmental sustainability. The company, located near Palembang, South Sumatera, operates on a 58-hectare factory site with two continuous production lines. Notably, SPF has been ISO 14001:2015 certified since March 15, 2021, reflecting its dedication to environmental standards.

SPF's Environmental Policy is intricately integrated into its Quality, Occupational Health and Safety, and Environmental Management Policies, showcasing a comprehensive approach to sustainability. Over the past year, the company addressed two prominent environmental concerns.

The first issue was surrounding dust in the neighbouring community, especially during the January-March period. To mitigate this, SPF took various measures, including planting trees and bamboo around the factory and conducting regular maintenance on machinery and air pollution control equipment.

Additionally, SPF engaged in Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programs to support the community and consistently monitored emissions and ambient air quality. Personnel involved in air pollution control obtained certifications to enhance expertise.

The second issue pertained to water pollution risk from process and domestic wastewater. SPF responded by establishing wastewater treatment facilities and implementing domestic liquid waste management. Frequent monitoring, sampling, and analysis were conducted to ensure adherence to environmental standards. Personnel responsible for water pollution control were also certified.

Through these proactive steps and long-term objectives, PT. Sumatera Prima Fibreboard sets a commendable example of responsible industrial practices in Indonesia, paving the way for a sustainable and environmentally conscious future.
